

GOVERNMENT OF ROMANIA

DECREE no. 22 dated the 29th of August 2009

regarding the establishment of the minimum amount of tuition fees, in foreign currency, of citizens who study on their own account in Romania, from states which are not members of the European Union, as well as from those which are not part of the European Economic Area and the Swiss Confederation

Pursuant to art. 108 of the Romanian Constitution, republished, and art. 1 points VII.1 and VII.3 of Law no. 253/2009 on empowering the Government to issue decrees, the Government of Romania adopts this decree.

Art. 1 - (1) Starting with the school year 2009-2010, the minimum amount of tuition fees, in foreign currency, of citizens who study on their own account in Romania, from the states which are not members of the European Union, as well as those which are not part of the European Economic Area and the Swiss Confederation is the one provided in the addendum which is an integral part of this Decree

(2) The university senates may establish the final amount of these tuition fees, complying with the conditions of the law.

(3) The amounts collected from the tuition fees stipulated in para. (1) are to be used according to the methodology approved by order of the Minister of Education, Research and Innovation, which is to be published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

Art. 2 - The provisions of this decree are to be applied starting with the school year 2009-2010. On the date of publication of this Decree, the Government Decree no. 13/1993 regarding the modification of the amount of tuition fees, in foreign currency, of citizens from other countries that study on their own account in Romania, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, no. 202 of 23 August 1993, approved by Law no. 102/1994, with the subsequent additions, shall be hereby repealed.

Art. 3 - This ordinance enters into force 3 days following its publication in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

ADDENDUM

The MINIMUM AMOUNT

of the tuition fees, in foreign currency, of the citizens who study on their own account in Romania, from the states which are not members of the European Union, as well as from those which are not part of the European Economic Area and the Swiss Confederation, starting with the year of education 2009-2010

A. Full-time education

1. Upper secondary high school education: 180 euro/month

2. Undergraduate and postgraduate education

The fees are paid throughout the school year, the periods of practice stipulated in the educational plans included. The fees are paid in advance for a 9-month period.

The cost of accommodation is added to the above fees as well as that of the meal in the cafeteria if such services are provided by the educational institution

B. Part-time education and other forms of education organized according to the law

a) High school education - upper secondary high school education: for each year of studies the fees for 3 months are to be paid in advance, the amount corresponding to the one specific to full-time education.

b) Bachelor studies: for each year of studies the fees for 3 months are to be paid, the amount corresponding to the one specific to the fields of education mentioned for full-time education. The overall fees are to be paid prior to the first exam session

c) Master, PhD studies:

1. the equivalent of the monthly fee set out in point A. A is to be paid for the admission interview;

2. for the advanced university training program, the payment of the fees will be made complying with the conditions set out in point A. A

3. for the scientific research program only the activities provided in the individual study plan are to be paid amounting to the equivalent of the monthly fee set out in point A. A

d) The fees to be paid for the school-leaving examination, the bachelor or the master degree examination or when defending one's PhD thesis, are provided in the table below
